

## WAIMEA TRAFFIC CRISIS ACTION PLANNING COMMITTEE

The purpose of this community committee will be

- 1. to encourage the completion of the Connector Road ASAP, including the use the County traffic bond funds for the County's section of this proposed road, and to encourage Parker Ranch's completion of the portion of this road that it is obligated to complete pursuant to its subdivision approvals;
- 2. to discourage the widening of the highway through town – as an alternate way to address the traffic problem rather than construction of the Connector Road [except for projects that are consistent with construction of the Connector Road, such as improvement of the Kamamalu Road intersection – where the Connector Road will connect on to Mamalahoa Highway];
- 3. Seek to identify ways that we can survive the traffic problem until the Connector Road is completed as an alternate way through and around the center of Town
- 4. Seek to coordinate efforts relating to the State Bypass Road (estimated completion date 2019) from the Kohala Coast to Mud Lane; and such other related traffic concerns; except that we will not address traffic safety issues that are being addressed by the Traffic Safety Committee -- other than to communicate with that Committee regarding any specific safety issues that we believe should be addressed
